# ANNUAL REPORT OF THE P.C.C. OF ST. ANDREW'S CHURCH ISLEHAM 2017/18.

During the past year the PCC. has met regularly to discuss all matters relating to the Church & Parish. It has been an eventful year.

Following Revd Mike's departure at the end of April 2017, much time was spent discussing matters relating to the ensuing "interregnum". These discussions included possible changes to the format of some of our Church Services & the need to find "locum" members of Clergy to cover some of those Services.

Whilst the search for a new Rector for the "Three Rivers Group" was on-going, the PCC was informed that the "Quinquennial inspection" of the Church building by the architect was due. As our previous architect, Mr Limentani, had retired the PCC needed to appoint a replacement for him.

In July, following much research, Revd Sue & several PCC members met with 3 architects, all approved by the Diocese, who had expressed their willingness to take on the care of St Andrew's Church. As a result of these meetings the PCC appointed Mr Nigel Walter of "Archangel Architects". His inspection of the Church took place in October.)

Church finances are discussed at each PCC meeting. As in previous years our fundraising events have been very successful. Both the August Bank holiday "Quilts exhibition" & the "Festival of Light" in December were well-supported. The Social Centre Tuesday "coffee mornings" are an excellent means of "outreach" to the wider village community, as well as contributing greatly to Church funds. The "newspaper" business has also been successful. Thanks are due to all those involved.

Much of the income received goes into the Church "Restoration fund" to be spent on the repair & maintenance of the Church building. However, we are still able to support both local & overseas charities. A substantial donation has been given to our village school recently, to support its fundraising for a new swimming pool "liner." We also continue to support the Soham "foodbank", & still send donations via the "Linkylea Trust" to an orphanage & school in India.

New methods of donating to church funds have been discussed. The PCC has agreed to join the "Parish Giving scheme," which promotes regular donations to Church funds by "direct debit" rather than by the weekly envelopes.

The PCC has also discussed how St Andrew's might become an "Eco" Church.

We continue to work closely together with the other Churches in our group. Our Churchwardens & some PCC members from throughout the group were closely involved in the selection process for a new Rector. We were all delighted when Revd David was appointed. His "Licensing" Service at Fordham, in October was a joyous occasion with representatives from all our Churches in attendance.

Other group activities include the monthly "Messy Church" & the annual "Holiday Club" held in July for children from 5-11yrs.

In September, together with PCC members from the other Churches in the group we agreed to fund Mel Takac as our "Pioneer Partner". Mel will work with our Ministry Team over the next 3 years whilst she explores her vocation. She was commissioned here in Isleham on December 3<sup>rd</sup> & has already made a great contribution to ministry in both our Church & the village school.

We continue to encourage & support our links with the other 2 village Churches. Once again members of High St Church helped organise the "Women's World day of Prayer" Service on Friday March 2<sup>nd</sup>. Despite the very cold weather members from both Churches attended & we look forward to working together again next year.

This year all 3 village Churches joined together at Pound Lane Free Church for the Good Friday Ecumenical Service.

We now look forward to working closely with Revd David, with the goal of becoming a "Missional" Church, exploring new ways of "outreach" to the wider village community.

Please continue to keep the Ministry Team & the PCC in your prayers.
